Education

Disability

VA Disability Compensation can mean a monthly, tax-free payment to Veterans who got sick or injured while serving in the military and to Veterans whose service made an existing condition worse. For more information, visit va.gov/disability/ or call the VA Benefits Hotline at (800) 827-1000.

VA Aid and Attendance or Household benefits

VA Disability benefits provide monthly payments on top of the standard monthly VA pension that qualified Veterans and survivors receive. If you need help with daily activities or if you're housebound, you can check your eligibility at: va.gov/pension/aid-attendance-housebound/.
