I am requesting funding for the Athletic Facilities Rehabilitation in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the New York City Department of Education, located at 52 Chambers Street, New York, NY, 10007. The funding would be used to replace outdated, in some cases 50–60 year-old, basketball infrastructure at multiple schools in NY08 including basketball court refurbishment, hoop replacement, other athletic upgrades and added safety padding. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve educational spaces in New York's Eighth Congressional District. It will also improve the experience and safety of students at Brooklyn's public schools.
